



2014 Phelps Creek Pinot Noir, Columbia Gorge

Bud-break came very early, putting the vines at extreme risk for Spring frost. The season progressed at a rapid pace with a generous span of moderate heat. Anticipation grew for the beginning of the earliest harvest in our 24 years of wine growing. The 100% estate grown fruit combines three clonal selections, Pommard, Dijon 115 & 777. The cool evenings provide beautiful acid balance. Our volcanic soils add spice and mineral elements. Barrel aged in French Oak.
